### SCRATCH OPTIONS:

**You must compete in either Division 1, 2 or 3 Handicap Events to be eligible to compete in these events.**

#### 1. MEMBERSHIP

The Wisconsin State Tournament will be open to all members of Wisconsin and Upper Peninsula Associations and will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the United States Bowling Congress. Non-members who reside in the jurisdiction of these Associations who are not members of another state association, can become eligible by the purchase of a USBC membership card. A non-resident of Wisconsin & Upper Peninsula Associations who is eligible for the state tournament in their state of residency must have participated in a minimum of 21 games at time of bowling in one league in a USBC chartered local association in Wisconsin or Upper Peninsula to be eligible.

- All USBC tournament rules will apply. Rule 303
- BOWLERS ELIGIBLE TO BOWL ONLY ONCE IN ANY EVENT.** Any member of a certified league is eligible to bowl on any team in this tournament.
- The number of players classified as **PROFESSIONAL BOWLERS** is limited to **NOT** more than two (2) such players on a five man team and **NOT** more than one (1) such player in a doubles pair. Such professionals are identified as and include: “Standard” and “Full”, National, Regional, Senior and Residential professionals. and must furnish prize winnings and scores from the last 12 month period at time of submitting entry blank.

#### 2. AVERAGES

a. Individual averages used to determine the handicaps are the highest USBC certified league average for the previous season (21 games or more) **in any association area.** THIS INCLUDES ESTABLISHED IN USBC YOUTH COMPETITION, COLLEGIATE AVERAGES NOT ACCEPTED. If no average from previous season based on 21 games or more, use the highest current season average at time of bowling in first event of all events entered. If no average from previous or current season based on 21 games or more, use 225. Summer season certified averages shall be accepted as official, if the bowler does not have an acceptable winter certified average.

b. If current league average is 15 or more pins higher than last year’s average, minimum 21 games, the bowler must use his current league average (at time of bowling in first event) for all events entered.

c. Tournament management reserves the right to adjust all reported averages that are lower than required and result in a lower classification or more handicap. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. **ALL ENTRANTS MUST REPORT PRIOR TOURNAMENT RERATES BEFORE BOWLING.**

d. As a condition of entry, a bowler who has won a prize of \$600.00 or more in the last 12 month period MUST, AT TIME OF SUBMITTING ENTRY BLANK REPORT his actual score, position and amount won (USBC Rule 319d). Bowlers are also cautioned to be aware of the average requirements of USBC Rule 319e.

e. When the average of a substitute changes the classification of an entry in any event, the entry shall be reclassified, including prize fees and handicapped accordingly.

f. Tournament management reserves the right to rerate any entrant prior to bowling. If the entrant refuses the rerate, the entry fees will be refunded.

g. Sports league averages will be adjusted in accordance with USBC Rule 205.

#### 3. SUBSTITUTION RULE Rule 324 b.

a. A captain of a team or his appointee may make a substitution of a bowler listed on the entry in order to realize fully the amount paid for entry fees.

b. Each substitute must bowl each event under his own full name.

c. **SUBSTITUTE MUST BOWL FOR THE SAME BOWLER IN ALL THE EVENTS TO QUALIFY FOR THE ALL-EVENTS PRIZE FUND.**

#### 4. SCORE OR AVERAGE CORRECTIONS

All score corrections and/or average adjustments must be reported within 72 hours or original score stands. Rule 327b.

#### 5. REFUNDS

**NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED - ALL OVERPAYMENTS OF \$1.00 OR LESS WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.**

#### 6. AVERAGE VERIFICATION

Average affidavits will be issued to those among the top ten in each division, each event. These are to be filled out by the league secretary to verify this year’s current highest average at the time of bowling. Those failing to return the affidavits, or incomplete affidavits, will result in loss of handicap and average will be adjusted to 225 scratch.

#### 7. CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS

Championship Awards will be awarded to Team Division 1 and Division 2 winners. The team or individuals registering the highest total pins, exclusive of handicaps (or deductions) will be recognized as the Scratch Champions. No duplicate awards. Championship Awards to winners of each division in Minor Events and All-Events. All Awards may be deducted from the prize fund.

#### 8. PRIZE LIST

Each division shares only in their own prize list. All divisions are based on a ratio of approximately 1-5. Top prize in either Team Event division is \$5,000.00, \$2,000.00 in all Doubles divisions, \$1,000.00 in all divisions of Singles and All-Events based on 1000 entries in a division. If less than 1000 entries in a division, 1st prize will be 10% of the total prize fees collected in the division of any event.
