WS USBC BADGER QUEENS TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The 2019 WS USBC Badger Queens Tournament is an individual scratch USBC certified adult women's tournament.
2. The Badger Queens Tournament is open to WS USBC members. Local memberships can be purchased prior to bowling. Proof of USBC and local membership may be required.
3. Minimum average of 170 required. Average must be from 2017-18 certified league, 2018 certified summer league or current 2018-19 season with at least 21 games in a certified league. Challenge league averages will be adjusted, using USBC Sport league chart.
4. All USBC rules and regulations shall govern this tournament along with specific rules as drawn up by the tournament committee and/or WS USBC Board of Directors.
5. The Tournament Director has discretion to remove any bowler from the tournament for an infraction of any of the following rules:
 - a. Violation of the dress code.
 - b. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of the tournament (foul language, gestures, etc.).
 - c. Consuming beverages or food in the bowling settee area.
 - d. Use of foreign substances which come in contact with the approaches, lanes or bowling equipment (including slide right or similar products, rosin, etc).
 - e. Altering the surface of a bowling ball after competition has begun.Disqualification of an individual shall result in forfeiture of her entry fee and any right to prize money and/or awards.

6. **Flash pictures and cell phone use is prohibited during tournament play.**

7. The WS USBC has the entrant's unqualified permission for use of her photograph for publicity purposes.

8. **DRESS CODE** Entrants are required to wear suitable attire.

- a. Entrants are required to wear a shirt/blouse with **contestant's current legal name** on the back in letters at least 1½ inches. City name is optional. Only last name is necessary. Materials will be available for \$5.00 for anyone without a name on their shirt.

9. **ENTRY FEE INFORMATION / PRIZE DISTRIBUTION**

- a. Entry fee is \$70.00 (\$40.00 Prize fee, \$30.00 Expense fee). The expense fee includes bowling fees, promotional and operational expenses.
- b. All paid entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis.
- c. Entries and fees received after tournament capacity has been reached will comprise waiting list. Fees will be refunded if bowler is not used as replacement.
- d. Bowlers not able to participate after entry has been received must call state office to determine if a waiting list is established before finding her own replacement. If no waiting list exists, bowler must notify office if replacement bowler is found.
- e. Prize money will be returned 100% at a ratio of 1:4
- f. First Place payout will be \$1,000 based on a minimum of 70 entries.
- g. Bowlers earning prize money will be paid by check, only.
 - 1) Bowlers finishing in the Top 5 will receive their checks immediately following the conclusion of the tournament.
 - 2) Remaining checks will be mailed after the completion of the tournament.

10. **QUALIFYING ROUND**

- a. The entire field of entrants shall report to the tournament office 45 minutes prior to squad time which is **9:00 AM**. It is at the discretion of the Tournament Director to replace any entrant(s) not registered 15 minutes prior to scheduled squad time.
- b. **CONTESTANTS WILL DRAW FOR STARTING LANE.**
- c. The qualifying round will consist of six (6) games with bowlers moving after each game.
- d. Entrants will receive 10 minutes of practice on their starting pair of lanes.
- e. Scores will be totaled after 6 games and the top 25% will advance to a 3 game Semi-final Round **with pin carry-over**.

11. **SEMI-FINAL ROUND**

- a. The Semi-Final round will consist of 3 games.
- b. Bowlers will draw for starting lane and move after each game.
- c. Top five bowlers will advance to step-ladder finals.

12. **STEP-LADDER FINALS**

- a. The step-ladder finals will begin when scores from the Semi-final round have been verified and positions have been determined.
- b. Step-ladder format is as follows: #5 Seed will bowl #4 Seed. Winner will advance to bowl #3 Seed. The winner will advance to bowl #2 Seed. The winner will advance to bowl #1 Seed for the Championship. Bowler on left lane will start each match.

13. **TIES**

- a. A 9th and 10th frame roll-off will determine all ties immediately following any tied game.
- b. Bowlers tied will draw for starting lanes. Bowler on odd lane will start tie-breaker.

THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR AND COMMITTEE SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO DECIDE ANY OTHER MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE OPERATION OF THE TOURNAMENT NOT COVERED BY THE ABOVE RULES.
