Team – Doubles - Singles Scholarship - All Events Scholarship
USBC JUNIOR GOLD TOURNAMENT QUALIFIER

1. Tournament is open to all Wisconsin and Upper Michigan USBC Youth members who have not reached their 20th birthday prior to August 1, 2018 unless under suspension or in violation of USBC youth eligibility rules.
2. Bowlers from different age divisions may bowl together. Teams or doubles may be boys, girls or mixed (boys and girls). **Bowlers cannot bowl doubles only or singles only.**
3. For available dates, times and entry blanks, call tournament manager. Reservations open **October 6 at 9:00 A.M.**, phone **(608) 253-7987**. Reservations close April 1, 2019.
4. **All entry fees and completed entry forms are due in the office of the Tournament manager eight (8) weeks after entries are received or a minimum of five (4) weeks before date of bowling.**
5. **Coach is responsible** for correct spelling on entry forms. **ANY NAME CORRECTIONS AFTER THE AWARDS ARE DISTRIBUTED WILL BE AT THE EXPENSE OF THE COACH.**
6. Tournaments will be conducted on an average basis as indicated on this entry form. Bowlers will qualify for individual awards in their divisions.
7. Handicap will be 90% difference between total entering team average and class high limit, for all classes. Class limits scores shall be as follows:

8. ENTERING AVERAGE: Average sheet or association average book **MUST** accompany entry form.
 - a) The highest certified league average as of the end of the previous winter season provided they have bowled 21 games. A book average would be recognized or the final league average sheet from the previous winter season and must accompany the entry blank.
 - b) If a bowler does not have a previous winter average, an average as of December 1, 2018 (minimum of 9 games) must be used.
 - c) If due to a late league start or other unusual circumstances a bowler does not have 9 games as of and including December 1, 2018, entrant will be permitted to bowl using their highest verifiable average (with a minimum of 9 games) as of time of bowling, subject to the approval of the tournament director.
 - d) A bowler who does not have the required minimum number of games bowled (9), will be accepted with an assigned average as follows:

11 years of age and under - 150 average	12 years of age and older - 200 average.

 - e) 10 pin rule, USBC Rule #319A, does not apply. This tournament will not use composite averages.

Local USBC secretaries/coaches will verify all entering averages. ALL AVERAGES MUST BE VERIFIED WITHIN 7 DAYS OF BOWLING OR RULE 8d will apply.

9. USBC rules and regulations will govern tournaments with the exception of Rule 322 – No absentee scores will be allowed. USBC eligibility rules will be strictly enforced.
10. Falsification of any entry will result in automatic disqualification of entire entry, with no refund of fee.
11. A bowler may enter and bowl once in each tournament event. Participants bowling doubles will remain on the same lanes for singles. Tournament Management reserves the right in emergency cases to permit a bowler from Host City who has already bowled to substitute if a member who has not bowled is unavailable. **Subs from cities other than Host City must have approval of Tournament Manager.**
12. If a substitution is made in any event, the substitute must take the place of the bowler he/she is replacing. Once the substitute is placed in the lineup, the substitute will finish the series. If an entry blank is submitted with a blank spot, you are requesting a sub. **A sub obtained by the site director, shall remain in the lineup unless 24-hour notice is received prior to bowling. All subs must be made 24 hours prior to your squad time. All subs after 24 hours are subject to availability and not guarantee. Rearranging of the lineups or changing of doubles partners will not be permitted; violation will be cause for disqualification.**
13. Awards will be given on the following basis: Individual awards will be given to all winning teams and doubles members on the basis of one (1) out of ten (10), or major portion thereof, entered in each class. Duplicate awards will be given in case of tie if first place is involved. Co-Champions will be declared.
14. **Only coaches or captains will check in all bowlers at least 45 minutes before bowling.** In case of an emergency, teams, doubles and singles not able to bowl on reserved date, may re-enter by calling tournament director for available openings.
15. Dress Code: No Torn Jeans, tank tops, crop tops, short skirts or short shorts, baggy pants, pajamas or hats. The dress code will be enforced and the tournament director will have the discretion to ask bowlers to change or be disqualified. Bowlers will not be allowed to use any electronic device (cell phones, IPODS, players MP3) while bowling.
16. No Parents or Coaches in Settee Area.
17. Junior Gold membership cards **MUST** be presented at check-in. Junior Gold entry fee is 25.00. Junior Gold entry will be awarded to 2 girl & 2 boy. Junior Gold will be based on 9 game total pin fall. Ties will be determined by High Series score from the 3 events bowled.
18. Tournament Manager has the final decision on all tournament matters.

To be invited to the 500-600 Club Tournament, Girls must bowl 500 Scratch - Boys 600 scratch while bowling in any event. It is the responsibility of the bowler and the coach to fill out form with information needed.

When combining team entries for singles or doubles, please list all team entry numbers. **Bowlers entered in both Doubles and Singles must be on the same entry form.**

Singles and All Events scholarships will be based on the number of entries in each class. 100% of money generated in a class will be given out in scholarships in that class.

All scholarships will be held in Smart Account #10665. The recipient must use the scholarship within eight (8) years of high school graduation
