Division 1 - 75 years and older

Division 4 - 60 to 64 years inclusive  
Division 5 - 55 to 59 years inclusive

**SCRATCH OPTIONS: You must compete in Handicap Events to be eligible to compete in these events.**

- Membership: The Wisconsin State Senior Tournament will be open to all members of Wisconsin and Upper Peninsula Associations and will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the United States Bowling Congress. USBC MEMBERSHIP CARDS WILL BE CHECKED at tournament site. Non-members who reside in the jurisdiction of these Associations can become eligible by the purchase of a USBC membership card. A non-resident of Wisconsin & Upper Peninsula Association must have participated in a minimum of 21 games as of the time of bowling, in one league in a USBC chartered local association in Wisconsin or Upper Peninsula to be eligible. Entrants must have reached their 55th birthday on or before the date they participate in tournament and are eligible to bowl ONLY ONCE in any event but must bowl both doubles and singles.
- Bowlers classified as "Professional" in any capacity, are limited to two (2) on a 4-person team and one (1) on any doubles team.
- The handicap is 90% of the difference between average and 225. Prize ratio will be 1-5. Each division shares in their own prize list.
- USBC Rules will govern the staging of this tournament. See Rule 303.
- ENTERING AVERAGES WILL BE RECOGNIZED IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:
  - Highest USBC certified league average, based on a minimum of 21 games or more, from the 2018-19 season (including summer leagues).
  - This year's current average at the time of bowling if it is 15 pins or more higher than above.
  - Leagues designated as **Sport/Challenge will be adjusted using the corresponding USBC average adjustment scale** if it is the only average available **from the same season**.
  - If no 2018-19 USBC average, use current average based on 21 games or more at the time of bowling. All averages must be verified one (1) week prior to bowling.
  - If you do not qualify under the above, you will be entered at 225.
  - Any bowler who has had his/her average adjusted/rerated in the past 10 years is required to report that average adjustment/rerate, whether the bowler accepted the adjustment/rerate or not, at the time of entry. **Failure to comply with these provisions is cause for a forfeiture of entry fees and prize winnings.**
  - Tournament management reserves the right to rerate any entrant prior to bowling. If the entrant refuses the rerate, the entry fees will be refunded.
  - As a condition of entry, a bowler who has qualified for a cash and/or merchandise prize of \$300 or more in the position standings prize list in any event in a tournament, \$500 or more in any one tournament of \$1000 or more in all tournaments within the last 12-month period, must give tournament management the following information prior to participation for possible average adjustment:
    - Name of each tournament, 2. The amount of the prize won, 3. The actual score bowled, 4. The prize positionFailure to comply with these provisions is a cause for a forfeiture of entry fees and prize winnings (USBC Rule 319d.)
- No abrasives/cleaners or other foreign substances may be used/applied to the ball once competition begins.
- Substitution Rule.
  - Each substitute must take the line-up position of the missing bowler.
  - No line-up changes or switching of partners.
  - Substitute must bowl for the same bowler in all the events to qualify for the paid all events prize fund.
- Championship awards will be given to the winners in Team and Doubles and to each division in Singles and All Events. The handicap All Events winner in each of the 5 divisions will receive a free entry into the 2021 National Senior's Tournament. In case of a tie, the high scratch total will decide the winner.
