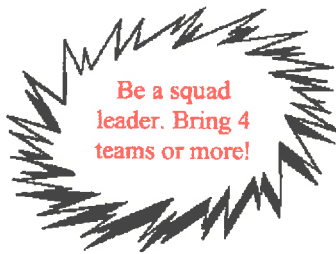
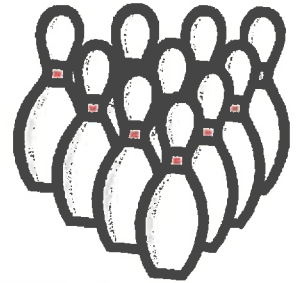

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Entrant must have a current membership with USBC and a local association within the jurisdiction of the WS USBC. This tournament will be certified by USBC and will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Wisconsin State USBC. Association membership will be available at the site.
2. Tournament will consist of mixed team (2 men & 2 ladies) and mixed doubles (1 man & 1 lady). Bowlers competing in both events may participate in Optional All Events by paying a fee of \$5.00 prior to bowling. Participation shall be limited to twice in team (must change at least two bowlers) and twice in doubles (must change at least one bowler) conforming to the above requirements. First events shall count towards bowler's all events score.
3. Entrants must use their highest certified league average (minimum 21 games) for the 2019 - 2020 season. **This year's current average at the time of bowling if it is 15 pins or more higher than 2019 - 20 season (minimum 21 games).** If no 2019 - 2020 average, use 2018 - 2019 season average. If no 2019 - 2020 or 2018 - 2019 season average, entrant may use highest current season average (minimum 12 games) at time of participation. Averages from leagues designated **Challenge or Sport** will be adjusted, using the corresponding USBC average adjustment scales, **if they are the only average available from that season.** All others bowl scratch.
4. If an entrant has been re-rated in any tournament in the past 10 years, they must report it to the bowling center tournament official prior to tournament play. If USBC, your local association, or any tournament has re-rated your average, you must use the re-rated average. If you have been barred or disqualified, or you refused a re-rate, you must report the fact to the tournament official at time of check-in, prior to bowling, for a possible re-rate in this tournament. Failure to do so could result in disqualification. This rule includes reporting of all certified and uncertified tournaments, including those using a modified format of American Ten pin (example: 9 pin tap.)
5. Handicap is 100% of 235.
6. Prize ratio will be at least one (1) in five (5) for Team, Doubles and All Events. All Events prize list will be separate for men and ladies. Prize fee will be returned 100%.
7. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his or her average. Failure to use correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average, thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than actual average.

Correction in averages can be made up to the end of the first game of a series. Or, if an extension of time has been granted in writing by tournament management before the end of the first game of a series, the correction can be made within 48 hours after the end of a series.
8. Substitutes will be allowed and must be reported as early as possible to the Tournament Director's office, but not later than thirty minutes prior to the start of the squad. Optional all events fee may be transferred if substitute replaces original entrant in both events.
9. All bowlers are to be present ½ hour before the scheduled time to bowl. Bowlers must present USBC membership cards or have proof of purchase of current membership card.
10. Tournament games cannot be rebowled, except as authorized by the tournament manager when scores are irretrievably lost in a scoring process.
11. The tournament committee shall have the power to hear and act on all protests arising from or under construction of the rules of the Badger State Mixed Tournament. This committee shall also decide any question not covered by the tournament rules.
12. The tournament opens October 17, 2020. Entries close the last squad of tournament, based on lane availability. Special squad times may be available upon request.
13. "No Refunds" for absentee bowlers.

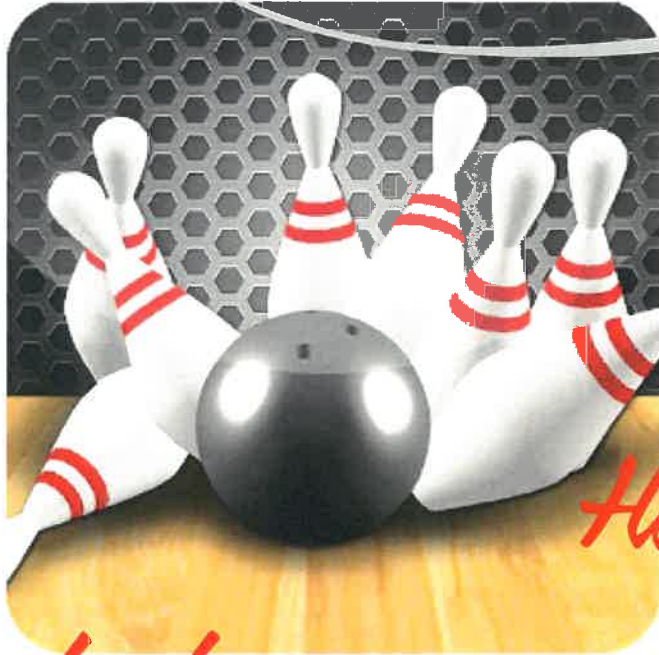
