Youth Masters / Junior Gold Qualifier Rules

1. This will be a USBC Certified Event. All USBC rules not covered by tournament rules apply.
2. If a bowler has not checked-in 15 minutes prior to shift time, they can be removed or replaced. Walk-ins and late entries will be accepted, subject to lane availability. Lanes will be pre-assigned on a first come first served basis.
3. USBC and Jr Gold membership cards **MUST** be presented at check-in. Memberships are available for purchase on site.
4. Tournament only open to Wisconsin State USBC Youth Bowlers.
5. Entrants must use their highest youth league average (min. of 21 games) from the 2019-2020 season to determine division placement. If no average, use your current average (minimum of 12 games). If no average, entrants will bowl in Division 1. All division 2 and 3 averages must be verified by 10/2/2020 or entrant will be placed in Division 1.
6. Scholarship money paid out in a 1:5 ratio. 100% of the scholarship money collected in each division will be returned within that division along with \$1,000 in additional money added by the Wisconsin State USBC.
7. Jr. Gold spots will be awarded based on entries for each division. U12 entries will advance at a 1 in 4 ratio. U15 entries will advance at a 1 in 6 ratio. U18 entries will advance at a 1 in 8 ratio. The next placement will be allowed to pay the difference in order to receive the next spot (example, if there are 12 entries in U18, one spot will be awarded and paid for, the 2nd placement will have the option to pay the difference \$100, for the next spot). In the event that there are not enough entries in a Jr. Gold division, the bowlers will have the opportunity to bowl in the next division or receive a refund of their Jr. Gold entry.
8. All scholarship money will be put in the bowlers USBC SMART Account.
9. Dress Code: no torn jeans, tank tops, crop tops, short skirts, or short shorts, pajamas, gym shorts, baggy pants or hats. The dress code will be enforced and the tournament director will have the discretion to ask bowlers to change or be disqualified. When in doubt, bring a second option.
10. Bowlers will not be allowed to use any electronic device (cell phones, iPods, etc.) while bowling unless tournament provides updates via internet.
11. \$30.00 fee will be charged for all NSF checks returned to the association.
12. Due to the Covid-19 virus and local restrictions, the field for this event is limited to the first 76 paid entries. This will allow us to have 2 bowlers per lane. All bowlers and spectators will be required to wear a mask or face covering unless actively eating or drinking. Bowlers will be allowed to lower their mask on the approach while bowling. We are also asking that bowlers limit themselves to one spectator per bowler in order to respect social distancing and local restrictions.
